THEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1923.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary short title Appropriation Law, 1924.
- 2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the Appropriatwelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1923, tion of £28,767 for an additional sum not exceeding the sum of twenty-eight twelve thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven pounds for de-months fraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such December, period.
