Provided always, that no co-surety, co-contractor, or codebtor shall be entitled to recover from any other co-surety, co-contractor, or co-debtor, by the means aforesaid, more than the just proportion to which, as between those parties themselves, such last mentioned person shall be justly liable.

Power to make Rules of Court.

3. The Governor, with the advice and assistance of the Chief Justice, may from time to time by writing under the hand and official seal of the Governor and the hand of the Chief Justice make Rules of Court for the better execution of the provisions of this Law. See ligprus g

Interpretation.

"Register" means the Dental Register to be kept under this Law.

"Medical Assessors" means the body of persons appointed as such under the provisions of the Medical Registration Law, 1917.

"Practitioner" means a person whose name is on the Register.
