Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Amendment) Law, 1927, and shall be read as one with the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law, 1922, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Amendment) Law, 1925, and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection Laws, 1922 to 1927.

Shooting game from motor ears at night time illegal.

Penalty.

2. The Principal Law, section 17, is hereby repealed and in place thereof the following section shall have effect:—

17. No person shall make use of:—

(a) decoys for the purpose of shooting, killing or taking game, except in the case of wild swans, wild geese and wild ducks of any kind; or

(b) motor cars at night time for the purpose of shooting game therefrom or shall in any way use motor cars at night time for the purpose of attracting and shooting game.

Any person convicted of an offence under this section shall be liable to be imprisoned for a term not exceeding three months.
