TO AMEND THE LAW WITH REGARD TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF LAWS.

BE it enacted:—

Short title

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Law, 1927, and shall be read as one with the Interpretation Law, 1901, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Interretation (Amendment) Law, 1925, and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Interpretation Laws, 1901 to 1927.

Amendment of Law 10 of 1901, sec. 6.

- 2. The Principal Law, section 6, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-sections:—
 - (18) The expression "Comptroller of Customs and Excise" means the Comptroller of Customs and Excise to the Government of Cyprus for the time being.
 - (19) The expression "Director of Land Registration and Surveys" means the Director of Land Registration and Surveys to the Government of Cyprus for the time being.
 - (20) The expression "Director of Education" means the Director of Education to the Government of Cyprus for the time being.
 - (21) The expression "Postmaster-General" means the Postmaster-General to the Government of Cyprus for the time being.
 - (22) The expression "Assistant District Judge" means Assistant District Judge appointed under the provisions of the Cyprus Courts of Justice Order, 1927.

Meaning of certain words in past Laws.

3. Wherever in any Laws, Proclamations, Regulations, or other enactments in force in Cyprus the words "Chief Collector of Customs and Excise," "Registrar General," "Chief Inspector of Schools," "Island Postmaster" or "Village Judge" occur, the words "Comptroller of Customs and Excise," "Director of Land Registration and Surveys," "Director of Education," "Postmaster-General" or "Assistant District Judge" respectively shall be read in place thereof.
