Preamble.

HEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1930, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it therefore enacted :--

Short title.

Appropria. tion of

£715,130.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law. 1930.

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the King or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1930, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Seven Hundred and Fifteen Thousand One Hundred and Thirty Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period.

Limitation of the sum to be spent on Personal

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule hereto may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred Emoluments. to therein ; provided that the total sum spent on Personal Emoluments during the year, appropriated under this Law, shall not exceed the sum of Three Hundred and Eighty Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty-three Pounds.
