1. This Law may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Motor Omnibuses) Continuance Law, 1931.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Reparation Impost Law, 1931.

Imposition of impost.

2. There shall be paid to the Treasurer on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1932, by the towns and villages set out in the first schedule to this Law the amount appearing against such town or village in such schedule:

Provided that the Governor may reduce all or any of such amounts or direct that any such amount may be paid by instalments.

Levying and collection of impost.

3.—(1) The amount payable by each town and village shall be levied upon and collected from the Orthodox-Christian inhabitants thereof in accordance with the provisions of the sections following:
