BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation Law, 1932.

2. Every Law made by the Governor by virtue of the power and authority conferred upon him by Letters Patent dated the 12th day of November, 1931, shall, unless some other time is therein specified for bringing it into operation, come into operation upon its publication in the *Cyprus Gazette*.

3. The Interpretation Laws, 1901 to 1928, shall, save as in this Law expressly provided, apply to every Law made by the Governor by virtue of the power and authority conferred upon him by Letters Patent dated the 12th day of November, 1931.

A.D. 1932. TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO MOTOR OMNIBUSES.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Motor Omnibuses) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporations (Motor Omnibuses) Law, 1930, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law), and the Municipal Corporations (Motor Omnibuses) Continuance Law, 1931, and the principal Law and the said Law and this Law may together be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Motor Omnibuses) Laws, 1930 to 1932.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained therein, all permits issued under the principal Law shall be valid and effective and shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1932.

Permits under principal Law to be valid and effective and to continue in force.

3. This Law shall be deemed to have commenced and come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1932.

Date of coming into operation.

TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CUSTOMS,
EXCISE AND REVENUE.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1899, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law).

Short title.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) The words "or by regulations made under this Law" shall be inserted in section 10 after the words "this Law" (line two).

Amendment of principal Law.

(b) The following section shall be inserted between section 21 and the expression "Wharfage Dues." :—

"Power to Governor in Council to make regulations.

21A.—(1) The Governor in Council may from time to time by Order make regulations with respect to all or any of the following matters:—

(a) The prescription of goods, wares or merchandise, imported into the Island and subsequently exported therefrom after modification thereof by local industry, on which drawback of duties of Customs shall be granted, paid or allowed;

(b) The conditions under which drawback of duties of Customs shall be granted, paid or allowed on such goods, wares or merchandise;

(c) The amount of such drawback;
