BE it enacted:

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Pensions Order Short title. in Council, 1929, (Amendment) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Pensions Order in Council, 1929, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order".

2. Clause 7 of the Principal Order is hereby amended Amendment by the addition at the end thereof of the following of the sub-clause:—

Principal Order.

"(g) On voluntary retirement, with the approval of the Governor in Council, for the purpose of facilitating the application of retrenchment measures."

A LAW TO IMPLEMENT CERTAIN TERMS OF A CONTRACT FOR THE EXTENSION OF FAMAGUSTA HARBOUR.

THEREAS by a deed between the Government of Cyprus and Sir Lindsay Parkinson & Co. Limited in connection with the Famagusta Harbour extension dated the twenty-eighth day of March, 1931, it was agreed (inter alia) that there should be certain exemptions from payment to the Government of Cyprus of certain dues:
