A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO THE A.D. 1933.
 PUBLIC OFFICERS' GUARANTEE FUND. 16 of 1933.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund (Amendment) Law, 1933, and shall be read as one with the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Laws, 1896 to 1930, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Laws, 1896 to 1933.

2. Section 14 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

Repeal of section 14 of Law 3 of 1896 and substitution of new section.

"14. Every person who is appointed to an office shall pay on and after the 30th April, 1933, into the fund in the manner hereinafter provided, and subject to the terms and conditions contained in this Law or in any regulations framed thereunder, an annual contribution at the rate of one per centum per annum of the amount (not exceeding one thousand pounds) for which security is required to be given by him:

Provided that no officer shall be required to contribute for more than five years in respect of any one amount for which security is required to be given."

3. Section 18 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "but if he is absent on vacation leave no contribution shall be required from the person who is appointed to act for him, in respect of the acting appointment".

Amendment of section 18 of Law 3 of 1896.

4. Sections 19 and 22 of the Principal Law are hereby repealed without prejudice to anything done or any payments made thereunder.

Repeal of sections 19 and 22 of the Principal Law.

This Law came into operation on 28th April, 1933.
