BE it enacted:-

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, Short title. Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment Law, 1933, and the Cyprus (Customs, 34 of 1933. Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 2) Law, 1933, (hereinafter together referred to as 36 of 1933. "the Order"), and the Order and this Law may together be cited as "the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order and Laws, 1931 to 1934".

Amendment 2. The First Schedule to the Order is hereby amended of First as follows: Schedule to the Order. (a) The expression "Cement .. 5cp. the cwt." shall be substituted for the expression "Cement" $4\frac{1}{2}cp$. the cwt." Schedule to the Order.

3. The Fourth Schedule to the Order is hereby amended Amendment as follows :-(a) By the deletion of the expression "Beer, ale, porter and all other malt liquors ". (b) By the deletion of the expression "Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials. Ninety-five per centum of the full rate.". (c) By the insertion therein of the following:— "Beer, ale, porter and all other Fifty per centum malt liquors \ ... Fish, dried, salted or pickled of the full rate. Flour, wheaten, including semolina, and crushed or ground One-third of the wheat ... full rate. Sixty per centum Cement ... of the full rate. Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials-

(i) in bottles Fifty per centum of the full rate:

(ii) in casks Sixty per centum of the full rate."

This Law came into operation on 16th January, 1934.
