BE it enacted :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Maritime Order short title. in Council, 1913, (Amendment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Maritime Order in Council, 1913, (hereinafter called "the Order"), and the Order and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Maritime Order in Council and Law, 1913 and 1934.

2. The fourth recital in the Order is hereby amended Amendment by the deletion of the words "at the said port" and by recital in the the substitution therefor of the words "in the Island".

3. The Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the Amendment word "Larnaca" and by the substitution therefor of the 5, 8, 9 and word "Famagusta" wherever it occurs in clauses 3, 5, 8, 9 10 of the Order. and 10.

A LAW TO AMEND THE LAW OF CIVIL WRONGS. [13th July, 1934. H. R. PALMER,

BE it enacted :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Civil Wrongs (Amend- Short title. ment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Civil Wrongs Law, 1932, (hereinafter called "the Principal 35 of 1932. Law "), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Civil Wrongs Laws, 1932 and 1934.

2. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion Insertion of immediately after section 23 of the following section :- new section 23A in Law 23A. Any person who maliciously publishes 35 of 1932. " Slander false and disparaging statements whether oral of goods. or otherwise concerning the goods of another person shall commit a civil wrong against such other person:

Provided that no plaintiff shall recover compensation in respect thereof unless he has suffered pecuniary damage thereby."
