BE it enacted:

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Foreign Tribunal Short title. Evidence (Amendment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Foreign Tribunal Evidence Laws, 1908 and 7 of 1908. 1933, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the 15 of 1933. Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Foreign Tribunal Evidence Laws, 1908 to 1934.
- 2. Section 6 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment the insertion of the following paragraph at the end of Section 6 of Law 7 of 1908.
 - "Where the person taking the examination is not in His Majesty's service, he may be paid a remuneration consisting of a fee of two pounds to which may be added a fee to be calculated by the Registrar of the Court at the rate of three pounds for each day of five hours."
- 3. Section 10 of the Principal Law is hereby amended Amendment by the insertion after the words "or matter" in line 6 of of Law 7 the words "or proceedings pending or intended to be of 1908. instituted".
