A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE GRANT OF A PENSION TO GEORGE JEFFERY, O.B.E.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Jeffery Pension Law, 1934.

Power to
grant
pension
to George
Jeffery.

2. Notwithstanding anything in the Cyprus Pensions Order in Council, 1929, or any Order or Law amending the same or in any Regulations made thereunder, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, as from the 1st day of January, 1935, to George Jeffery, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, a pension at the rate of two hundred pounds per annum in respect of his service as Curator of Ancient Monuments.

This Law came into operation on 12th October, 1934.
