- (2) No Court fees shall be payable in respect of any prosecution so instituted for the breach of any regulation.
- (3) The Commissioner may compound any offence under this Law in the manner provided by the Compounding of Offences Laws, 1901 and 1926."
- 6. Section 13 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of section 13 and the following section substituted therefor:

"Disposal of contributions, etc.

13. All contributions and penalties paid or and substitution of new recovered under the provisions of this Law section. and any compensation paid or recovered for any damage to a fuel ground shall be paid into the Fuel Ground Fund and shall be applied for the purposes of this Law."

BE it enacted:

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Mines short title. Corporation (Exemption from Duties of Customs) Amendment Law, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Mines Corporation (Exemption from Duties of Customs) Law, 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal 32 of 1934. Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Mines Corporation (Exemption from Duties of Customs) Laws, 1934 and 1935.
- 2. Paragraph (a) of section 3 of the Principal Law is Amendment hereby amended by the insertion after the word "inclusive" of section 3 of Law (line 5) of the words "and between the 1st day of June, 32 of 1934. 1935, and the 31st day of December, 1937, both days inclusive".
