A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CUSTOMS, EXCISE AND REVENUE.

BE it enacted:

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, short title. Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, (Amendment) 2 of 1932. Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus 42 of 1932. (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order and Laws, 1931, to 43 of 1932. (No. 2) 1935, (hereinafter called "the Order"), and the 34 of 1933.
