WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1935.

BE it enacted:-

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Law, 1936.

Appropriation of £23,042 for twelve months ended 31st December, 1935.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1935, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of twenty-three thousand and forty-two pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:—
