A LAW TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1936.

HEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1936.

BE it therefore enacted:-

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary short title. Appropriation Law, 1937.
