A LAW TO AMEND THE COMPANIES (LIMITED LIABILITY) Laws, 1922 to 1934.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Companies (Limited Short title. Liability) Amendment Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 18 of 1931 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the 4 of 1934 Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1938.

2. Section 9 of the Principal Law shall be amended by the Amendment addition thereto of the following sub-section:-

Principal

"(6) Where a licence granted in pursuance of section Law. 20 to a company the name of which contains the words 'Chamber of Commerce' is revoked, the company shall, within a period of six weeks from the date of the revocation or such longer period as the Governor may think fit to allow, change its name to a name which does not contain such words.

If a company makes default in complying with this sub-section, it shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds for every day during which the default continues."

3. The following section shall be inserted in the Principal Insertion of Law immediately after section 9 thereof:—

new section 9A in the Principal

" Restriction on registration of companies by certain names.

- 9A.—(1) No company shall be registered Law. by a name which-
 - (a) contains the words 'Chamber of Commerce' unless the company is a company which is to be registered under a licence granted in pursuance of section 20 without the addition of the word 'Limited' to its name; or
 - 'Building the words (b) contains Society'.

- (2) Except with the consent of the Governor no company shall be registered by a name which—
 - (a) contains the words 'Royal' or 'Imperial' or in the opinion of the Registrar suggests, or is calculated to suggest, the patronage of His Majesty or of any Member of the Royal Family or of the Governor or connection with His Majesty's Government or any department thereof; or
 - (b) contains the words 'Municipal' or 'Chartered' or in the opinion of the Registrar suggests, or is calculated to suggest, connection with any municipality or other local authority or with any society or body incorporated by Royal Charter; or
 - (c) contains the word 'Co-operative'."

Amendment of section 20 of the Principal Law.

- 4. Section 20 of the Principal Law shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section:—
 - "(5) Where the name of the association contains the words 'Chamber of Commerce' the notice to be given as aforesaid shall include a statement of the effect of the provisions of section 9 (6)."
