BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1938, (hereinafter called " the Principal Law "), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938.
2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion in the definition of "British Empire" of the word "Burma," immediately after the word "India,".
3. Section 25 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:-
"No claim 25. The Customs shall not be liable for any for compensation for loss, etc., unless by intentional or negligent act. loss, damage or destruction of any goods subject to the control of the Customs unless such loss, damage or destruction is caused intentionally or by negligence by a person employed by the Customs."
4. Section 29 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from sub-section (1) thereof of the words "at the port or place of importation".
5. Section 44 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from sub-section (6) thereof of the words "section 50 " and the substitution therefor of the words " section 49 ".
6. Section 49 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from paragraph $(d)$ thereof of the words "manifest error" and the substitution therefor of the word " mistake".
7. Section 55 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) thereof of the words " possesses the standard required for sale and competition in British markets" and the substitution therefor of the words " is sound, clean and fit for sale and consumption in British markets ".
