A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FORTY.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1940, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1940.

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated Appropriato the service of the King or which may be hereafter tion of £874,715. lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1940, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Eight Hundred and Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifteen Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period.

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under Limitation of each head in the Schedule hereto may be issued and spent sums to be spent. in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation Date of on the 1st day of January, 1940.
