THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS No. 27 of 1940.

A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment Short title. No. 2) Law, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, (hereinafter referred to as 31 of 1936 "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this $\frac{32}{21}$ of 1937 Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to 34 of 1938 10 of 1940 (No. 2) 1940.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Law is hereby Amendment amended by the deletion of Item 105 and the substitution of the First Schedule to therefor of the following Item :--
