BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

16 of 1940 13 of 1941 1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Volunteer Force (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 and 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941.

Amendment of section 7 of the principal Law.

2. Section 7 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion after the word "years" in the second line of the words "or the duration of the present war, whichever may be the longer period,".

Amendment of the First Schedule to the principal Law.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion after the word "years" of the words "or the duration of the present war, whichever may be the longer period,".
