THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 6 of 1942.

A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING ONE MILLION, TWO HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FORTY-TWO.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such Preamble. expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1942, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, short title. 1942. Appropriation of £1,293,599. 2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the King or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1942, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of One Million, Two Hundred and Ninety-Three Thousand, Five Hundred and Ninety-Nine Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period.

Limitation of sums to be spent.

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule hereto may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

Date of coming into operation. 4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1942.

A LAW TO AMEND THE RURAL CONSTABLES LAWS, 1932 TO 1937.

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Rural Constables short title. (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Rural Constables Laws, 1932 to 1937, (hereinafter 62 of 1932 referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Rural Constables Laws, 1932 to 1942.

2. Section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended Amendment as follows :---

(a) by the deletion from sub-section (1) of the words $\frac{\text{principal}}{\text{Law.}}$ "on a day to be appointed by the Mukhtar and not later than the 7th day of December in every two years" and the substitution therefor of the words "between the 1st day of November and the 15th day of December in every two years";
