A LAW TO AMEND THE COUNCILS AND BOARDS OF THE ARMENIAN CHURCH IN CYPRUS (VALIDATION AND REGULATION) LAW, 1937.

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Councils and Boards Short title. of the Armenian Church in Cyprus (Validation and Regulation) (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Councils and Boards of the Armenian Church in Cyprus (Validation and Regulation) Law, 1937, 6 of 1937 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Councils and Boards of the Armenian Church in Cyprus (Validation and Regulation) Laws, 1937 and 1942.

Amendment of section 3 (1) (b) of the principal Law.

Amendment of section 4 (2) of the principal Law.

Commencement. 2. Paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion thereform of the word "five" in line 3 and the substitution therefor of the word "eight".

**3.** Sub-section (2) of section 4 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "five" in line 5 and the substitution therefor of the word "eight".

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 14th day of May, 1942.
