A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS, 1932 TO 1942.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment Short title. No. 2) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal 40 of 1932 Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together 9 of 1933 be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to (No. 2) 1942.

2. Section 38 of the principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of and the following substituted therefor:-

"Consumption duty.

38. There shall be paid in the manner hereinafter provided upon every oke of manu- of new factured tobacco consumption duty at the rate of eighteen shillings and seven piastres."

3. Sub-section (1) of section 51 of the principal Law is Amendment hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the 51 (1) of the words "save with the permission in writing of the principal Law. Comptroller."

4. The Tobacco (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1940, is hereby Repeal. 31 of 1940 repealed.
