A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF SAGE LEAVES.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Sage Leaves Short title. (Protection) Law, 1942.
  - 2. In this Law— "sage" means the plants Salvia cypria, Kotschy, Salvia triloba L and Salvia grandiflora Etling.

Interpreta-

3.—(1) No person shall gather leaves from sage except Gathering of during such period as may be fixed by order of the Governor in Council:

Provided that nothing in this sub-section shall apply fixed by to the uprooting of sage on any land for the purpose of Governor in Council. cultivating such land.

(2) Any person who gathers leaves from sage except in the period fixed under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to a fine not exceeding five pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine.
