A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADES AND INDUSTRIES
(REGULATION) LAW, 1937.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trades and Industries (Regulation) (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Trades and Industries (Regulation) Law, 1937, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Trades and Industries (Regulation) Laws, 1937 and 1942. Short title.
30 of 1937.

2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order :— Amendment
of section 2
of the prin-
cipal Law.

“ ‘ Commissioner ’ means the Commissioner of Labour ; ”

3. Certificates of registration issued by the Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner of any District prior to the commencement of this Law shall remain in full force and effect until the 31st day of December, 1942. Saving.
