1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment No. 3) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to (No. 2) 1942, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to (No. 3) 1942.

Repeal of section 38 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. Section 38 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

“Consumption duty.

38. There shall be paid in the manner hereinafter provided upon every oke of manufactured tobacco consumption duty at the rate of one pound three shillings and two piastres.”
