## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 18 of 1943.

A Law to amend the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Health (Villages) Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, (hereinafter 19 of 1936 referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law 19 of 1938 and this Law may together be cited as the Public Health 21 of 1939 Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1943.

Amendment of section 9 (1) (c) (i) of the principal Law.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 9 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (c) thereof of the words "not exceeding five shillings" and the substitution therefor of the words "not exceeding one pound".

Substitution of "one pound" for "five shillings" in rules. 3. Whenever in any rules made by a Village Health Commission it is provided that an annual rate not exceeding five shillings may be assessed by the Village Health Commission the words "not exceeding five shillings" shall be deleted and the words "not exceeding one pound" shall be substituted therefor.
