THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 9 OF 1945.

A LAW TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CUSTOMS.

[29th August, 1945.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1945.

Insertion of

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after section 94 of the following section:—

“ Sale of
used Naval,
Army and
Air Force
goods or
material.

94A.—(1) Upon the sale in the Colony by the proper Naval, Army, or Air Force Authority, of any used goods or used material the property of any department of His Majesty's Government, there shall be paid by such Authority a duty at the rate of fifteen per centum on the amount realised by the sale of such goods or material.

(2) Duty under the preceding sub-section shall be payable whether or not the goods or material would be subject, except for their importation by the relevant Authority, to any other duty under the provisions of this Law; but upon payment of the duty prescribed in sub-section (1) of this section no other duty shall be payable in respect of such goods or material.”
