THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 2 OF 1946.

A LAW MAKING PROVISION FOR THE INCORPORATION IN
THE APPROPRIATE LAW OF THE PROVISIONS OF CERTAIN
DEFENCE LEGISLATION.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Adminis-
tering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of
the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Defence Legislation Short title.

2. The Laws referred to in the first column of the Schedule to this Law are hereby amended in accordance with the directions set out in the second column of the said Schedule.

3. This Law shall come into operation on the 24th day of February, 1946.

SCHEDULE.

Short title.	Amendment.
The Compensation (Defence) Law, 1940.	In sub-section (1) of section 2, insert the following definitions in their appropriate alphabetical order :— “prescribed” means prescribed by Rules made by the Governor; “the emergency” means the emergency that was the occasion of the passing of this Law.
The Export Duty Law, 1940.	In the proviso to sub-section (1) of section 5, substitute the words “ten per centum” (line 3) by the words “twenty per centum”.
The Fines and Penalties Recovery Law, 1883.	Substitute section 2 and the marginal note thereto by the following section and marginal note :— “Penalty 2. Any penalty ordered to be paid may when to be paid forthwith or at such subsequent time or by such instalments, as the Court making the Order may think fit.”
The Forest Law, 1939.	In sub-section (5) of section 9, insert, immediately before the words “the same” (line 6), the words “a summary of”.
The Newspaper, Books, and Printing Presses Laws, 1934 to 1944.	Delete section 23.
