## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 18 of 1946.

A Law to appropriate a sum not exceeding Three Million, Five Hundred and Twenty-Three Thousand, Six Hundred and Seven Pounds to the Service of the Twelve Months ending the Thirty-First Day of December, in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such Preamble. expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1946, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, short title. 1946.
