**B** E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

2. Section 38 of the principal Law (as set out in Law 23 of 1945) is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

" Consumption duty. 38. There shall be paid, in the manner hereinafter provided, upon every oke of manufactured tobacco, consumption duty at the rate of three pounds, two shillings and eight piastres."
