A LAW TO AMEND THE CYPRUS COINAGE ORDER, 1900.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Coinage Order, (Amendment) Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Coinage Order, 1900 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), and the Order and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Coinage Order and Law, 1900 and 1948.

2. Paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of sub-paragraph (c) and the substitution therefor of the following sub-paragraph:—

“(c) in the case of coins of copper, bronze or mixed metal of denominations not less than 9 piastres or one Cyprus shilling for the payment of any amount not exceeding 540 piastres or sixty Cyprus shillings but for no greater amount;”

(b) by the insertion therein immediately after sub-paragraph (c) of the following sub-paragraph:—

“(d) in the case of coins of copper, bronze or mixed metal of denominations less than 9 piastres or one Cyprus shilling for the payment of any amount not exceeding 27 piastres or three Cyprus shillings but for no greater amount.”

3. Paragraph (2) of Article 9 of the Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words “9-piastre piece” (line 5) of the words “or the Cyprus shilling piece”.
