A LAW TO REPEAL THE PUBLIC OFFICERS' GUARANTEE
FUND LAWS AND TO AUTHORIZE REFUNDS TO
CERTAIN CONTRIBUTORS.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Officers' Short title.

2. In this Law—

“contributions” includes any other amount carried to the credit of a contributor under the provisions of the Public Officers’ Guarantee Fund Laws, 1896 to 1937, and “fund” means the Public Officers’ Guarantee Fund established under the provisions of the said Laws.

3. The Treasurer shall, so soon as may be convenient, refund to every traceable contributor to the fund who, on the 1st July, 1948, has contributions standing to his credit in the books of the fund, the whole amount of such contributions.

4. The balance remaining in the fund after the refunds mentioned in section 3 are made, shall be paid into the Treasury and shall form part of the general revenue of the Colony.

5. Any untraceable contributor who on the 1st July, 1948, has contributions standing to his credit in the books of the fund or in the case of a deceased contributor his legal personal representative may, within a period of six years reckoned from the 1st July, 1948, apply to the Treasurer to be paid the amount of such contributions and the Treasurer, on being satisfied as to the correctness of such claim, shall issue a certificate certifying the sum due whereupon the same shall be paid out of the general revenue of the Colony.

6. Any claim not reaching the Treasurer within the period mentioned in section 5 shall not be entertained and shall be deemed to be barred.

7. The Public Officers’ Guarantee Fund Laws, 1896 to 1937, are hereby repealed.
