THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 39 OF 1948.

A LAW TO CONSOLIDATE THE PROVISIONS RELATING TO
CERTAIN RIGHTS OF CERTAIN NURSING SISTERS.

WHEREAS by the Nursing Sisters Pensions Law, 1928, 23 of 1928
provision was made for retiring allowances to
Nursing Sisters :

AND WHEREAS the said Law was repealed by the Nursing
Sisters Pensions (Repeal) Law, 1936 : 42 of 1936

AND WHEREAS, notwithstanding the said Repeal Law,
the rights of certain persons were saved by the Nursing
Sisters Pensions (Répeal) Amendment Law, 1938 : 13 of 1938

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to consolidate the provisions relating to the said rights :

BE it, therefore, enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Nursing Sisters (Preservation of Rights) Law, 1948.

2. Nothing in the repeal of the Nursing Sisters Pensions Law, 1928, shall affect—

(a) any retiring allowance granted thereunder to any matron or nursing sister ;

(b) the grant of a retiring allowance thereunder to any matron or nursing sister who ceased to serve under the Government of the Colony prior to such repeal and who would, but for such repeal, be eligible on her ultimate retirement to receive a retiring allowance under the provisions thereof in respect of her service under the Government of the Colony.

3. The proviso to section 2 of the Nursing Sisters Pensions (Repeal) Law, 1936, as enacted in section 2 of the Nursing Sisters Pensions (Repeal) Amendment Law, 1938, is hereby repealed.
