A LAW TO AMEND THE STAMP LAWS, 1923 TO (No. 3) 1944.

Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Stamp (Amendment) Short title. Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Stamp Laws, 31 of 1923 1923 to (No. 3) 1944 (hereinafter referred to as "the $\frac{27}{19}$ of $\frac{1926}{1927}$ principal Law "), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Stamp Laws, 1923 to 1948.

2. Item 2 (relating to Agreements) of the Schedule to the principal Law (as set out in Law 36 of 1944) is hereby amended by the insertion therein, under the heading "Exemptions" immediately after paragraph (c), of the following paragraph :---

"(d) agreement relating to the lease of immovable property entered into by the government of any foreign Power, which the Governor may direct to be exempted, regard being had to any arrangement made between such Power and His Majesty's Government for reciprocal exemption."
