THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 12 of 1949.

A Law to provide for the continuance of the provisions of the Cyprus Criminal Code, 1928 to 1948, by virtue of this Law.

WHEREAS the reprint of the Laws and the publication of a consolidated edition is under consideration:

And whereas it is desirable that the provisions of the Cyprus Criminal Code, 1928 to 1948, should be included in the consolidated edition as aforesaid in the form of a Law enacted wholly in the Colony:

BE it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Criminal Code Short title. (Continuance of Provisions) Law, 1949.

Repeal of the Laws in Schedule.

Date of coming into operation.

2. The Laws set out in the Schedule to this Law are hereby repealed.

3. Notwithstanding the repeal in section 2 of this Law. provisions of the provisions of the Cyprus Criminal Code, 1928 to 1948. shall, by virtue of this Law, continue to have the force of Law as though such provisions were set out in full in this Law.

> 4. This Law shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor by notice in the Gazette.
