## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS No. 29 of 1949.

A LAW TO REGULARIZE CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE IN THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1948.

THEREAS the Appropriation Law, 1948, made certain 31 of 1948. provision for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1948, and whereas it is necessary to make certain additional provision for the public service for the said period.

BE it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---
