THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

A LAW TO AMEND THE CERTIFYING OFFICERS LAW, 1888.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Certifying Officers Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Certifying Officers Law, 1888, (hereinafter referred to 8 of 1888. as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Certifying Officers Laws, 1888 and 1950.

2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment the insertion therein, immediately after the words "One of section 2 to each District Commissioner;" (line 7) of the words principal "one to the Colonial Secretary;"

3. Section 8 of the principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of and the following section substituted therefor: "Fee.

8. A fee not exceeding two shillings shall be payable to a certifying officer in respect of of new every signature or seal certified by him under the provisions of this Law."
