A LAW TO REGULARIZE CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE IN THE
TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST
DAY OF DECEMBER, 1951.

WHEREAS the Appropriation Law, 1951, made certain 15 of 1951.
