A LAW TO AMEND THE ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT LAW, 1952. 23 of 1952.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Electricity Development Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Electricity Development Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred 23 of 1952. to as “the principal Law”).

2. Section 28 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of sub-section (3) of the following paragraph:—

“(a) so as to transfer to and vest in the Authority without any conveyance, assignment or transfer whatsoever, free from all charges, encumbrances, rights or obligations of any nature, all the property and assets owned and used by the former undertaker or, having been paid for by such undertaker, used or employed by him at the date of the vesting order for the purposes of the undertaking, anything contained in section 21 of the Immovable Property (Tenure, Registration and Valuation) Law or any contract or agreement notwithstanding; and”.
