**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade Unions (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Trade Unions Law (hereinafter referred to as " the principal Law ").
