BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade Unions Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Trade Unions Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Cap. 172 15 of 1955) Law "). Amendment of the First Schedule to the principal Law. 2. Paragraph 5 of the First Schedule to the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following sub-paragraph (the existing part thereof being numbered as sub-paragraph (1)) :—

"(2) For the purposes of this paragraph the expression ' trade union' does not include any federation of two or more trade unions or any body of persons established for the co-ordination of the activities of any trade union or branch thereof."
