37 of 1953 A LAW TO AMEND THE LAND ACQUISITION (PAPHOS EARTHQUAKE) LAW, 1953.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Paphos Earthquake) (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Land Acquisition (Paphos Earthquake) Law, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Land Acquisition (Paphos Earthquake) Laws, 1953 and 1954.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the insertion therein after the words "any land" (line 2) of the following commas and words:—
", wherever situated,";

(b) by the insertion therein after paragraph (d) of the following paragraph (the full stop at the end of paragraph (d) being substituted by a semi colon):—

"(e) for the purpose of erecting any building or structure of a public nature, for use as a school, social welfare centre, community centre or for such other public purpose as, in the opinion of the Commissioner, will assist the relief of suffering and promote the well-being of the community of a village affected by earthquake."
