THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

A LAW TO AMEND THE ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT LAWS, 23 of 1952
1952 AND 1953. 15 of 1953

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Electricity Development (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 and 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 to 1954. 2. Section 25 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (c) thereof of the following paragraph :—

“(c) payment of any Government tax, or any rate of any local authority, in respect of any supply line.”

3. Sub-section (1) of section 33 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for the words “sub-sections (1) and (2)” (line 28) of the words “sub-section (1)”.

4. Sub-section (1) of section 38 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :—

“(1) Compensation or other moneys payable under the provisions of this Part in respect of any property or undertaking acquired by the Authority under the provisions of this Part shall be discharged as soon as the amount has been agreed or otherwise finally determined under the provisions of this Law together with interest thereon at the rate of four per centum per annum as from the date of the acquisition to the date of final payment :

Provided that where any sum is paid or offered for payment by the Authority on account of such compensation or other moneys such interest shall be payable on the amount of such compensation or other moneys from the date of the acquisition to the date of such payment or offer and thereafter on any balance to the date of final payment :

Provided further that in the case of any property or undertaking acquired by the Authority under the provisions of this Part on or before the first day of January, 1954, no such interest shall be payable in respect of any compensation or other moneys agreed to and paid in full settlement thereof.

5. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th day of October, 1952.
