BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

Cap. 285 5 of 1954 r. This Law may be cited as the Government Employees Provident Fund (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Government Employees Provident Fund Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Amendment of section 16 of the principal Law.

- 2. Sub-section (2) of section 16 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor:—
- "(2) Any part of such bonuses and interest not paid as aforesaid shall remain in the Fund and shall accrue for the benefit of other depositors therein.".

Date of commence-ment.

3. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1954.
