A LAW TO AMEND THE STAMP LAW.

CAP. 302

R. P. Armitage, [13th April, 1955.

Governor.

E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Stamp (Amendment) Short title, Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Stamp Law Cap. 302. (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Amendment of the Schedule to the principal Law. 2. The Schedule to the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—
