A LAW TO AMEND THE NURSING AND MIDWIFERY LAWS,
1951 AND 1955.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Nursing and Midwifery (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Nursing and Midwifery Laws, 1951 and 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Nursing and Midwifery Laws, 1951 to (No. 2) 1955.

Short title.

Repeal of section 10 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

2.—(1) Section 10 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“ Special licence to practise nursing.

10. Notwithstanding anything in this Law contained, the Registrar, if so directed by the Council, shall issue a special licence to any person who, on the first day of January, 1955, is *bona fide* engaged in nursing and who—

(a) applies therefor before the first day of January, 1957 ; and

(b) satisfies the Council that he or she has been so engaged for not less than three years immediately before the first day of January, 1955,

and the Registrar shall keep, publish and revise a list of such persons so specially licensed in the same manner as the Register of nurses.”.

(2) Any special licence granted under the section hereby repealed shall be deemed to have been granted under the substituted section.

Repeal of section 6 of Law 23 of 1955.

3. Section 6 of the Nursing and Midwifery (Amendment) Law, 1955, is hereby repealed.

Date of coming into operation.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the seventh day of July, 1955.
