1. This Law may be cited as the Evidence (Amendment) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Evidence Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Amendment) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Wireless Telegraphy Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy Laws, 1952 and 1955.
